

Parent Rights During Middle and High School

- Parents have the right to visit their child's classroom and observe the activities.
- Parents have the right to request a conference with their child's teacher.
- Parents have the right to examine the curriculum of their child's class.

Parent Rights During Middle and High School

- Parents have the right to be informed of their child's academic progress in school.
- Parents have the right to access their child's school records to check for inaccuracies or other problems.
- Parents have the right to be notified if their child is absent from school.

Parent Rights During Middle and High School

- Parents have the right to be notified of school rules, policies, codes, and procedures; and have the right to be informed of any changes.
- Parents have the right to be informed of the standards their child is expected to meet.
- Parents have the right to volunteer and be apart of various school committees.

Parent Rights During Middle and High School

- Parents have the right give the school feedback on courses that their child takes.
- Parents of children with a disability (physical or mental) have the right to make sure that their child is being cared for properly.
